



## CHETNA- An Awakening PREFACE

Chetna Welfare Society (Regd.), established in 2001, today it is one of the leading NGOs (non-profit non-governmental organisation) in the vicinity of Faridabad. Popularly known as Chetna was founded by a group of social workers with the main aim of rehabilitating the Divyang Children and bringing them in the main stream of the society. Although the present Government appears to be quite serious on this issue, yet the onus also lies on the Society to take up the cause of such children more seriously, and Chetna is actively involved in improving the lot of Divyang children and also the Street Children. Chetna Welfare Society's aim is to provide Divyang children appropriate physiotherapy facility supported with special educator and speech therapist, and of-course the basic education and improving their personal hygiene, resultantly to make them self-dependent to the extent possible and bring them in the main stream of the society. Chetna is also supporting Street Children by giving them appropriate education upto primary level and then able to pursue the children and their parents for higher education. Chetna is also contributing significantly in Women Empowerment. Chetna initially started in two rented rooms has now its own building on a plot of 600 sq. yds. at Sohna Road, Sanjay Colony, Near Punjab National Bank, Sector-23, NIT, Faridabad.



Chetna Welfare Society in its continued untiring endeavour to render excellent services to Divyang children, Street Children and Women **Empowerment thru Vocational Training Centres** in Tailoring, Beauty Culture and Computer learning for weaker section of the society, it completed another year of excellent performance during the year 2018-2019. Chetna, a service oriented NGO, continuously strived to make Divyang and Street children and women from poor segment of the society selfdependent to the extent possible and bringing them in the main stream of the society. Nevertheless, these milestones have been achieved with the dedicated efforts of the Management Committee, the staff and the above all the honourable donors and associates who extended sustainable support wholeheartedly.


Divyang children, whose total number of such children as on date registered with Chetna is 190 received excellent support in terms of Physiotherapy, Special Educator, Speech Therapist besides basic education, skill development and awareness on hygiene, which has helped greatly in improving their lifestyle. These children also performed cultural activities in functions organised in the campus from time to time which gave them wide exposure in building their self-confidence. Skill development training being imparted to them in making Candles, File Covers, Decorative Diyas, Decorative Tokris, Shagun envelopes has helped them in shaping their future and efforts to bring them in the main stream of the society.

- Physiotherapy Centre a reasonably wellequipped physiotherapy facilities with the help of a qualified Physiotherapist. Around 20 children were major beneficiaries of the project.
- Special Educator provided professional skill in different trades
- Speech Therapist provided help in improving speech problems
- Transport facility The NGO hires Eco Van for transportation of these special children for to and fro residence to school.



The Management Committee of Chetna Welfare Society, taking serious note of the plight of children from surroundings of its vicinity, who used to roam aimlessly on the roads, pick up fights using filthy language, pick up rags, and engaging themselves in other bad habits, established Satyabhava School for Street Children in the year 2008. Now the number of such children taking benefit of this school goes above 180 The Team - Chetna continued its efforts to make these children at par with other reputed schools. The dedicated Team of Staff of Chetna treat such children with love and care so as to maintain their attraction towards the school. Help of motivators and educationists is also sought from time to time for these children and their parents so that parents get motivated to send their wards to the school regularly. The noteworthy feature of Team Chetna is that after the students pass out 5th class, regular contact is maintained with their parents and persuaded them to send to senior schools and every possible help is provided to them. It is heartening to note that several such children with the support of Chetna completed 10+2, BA, B.Com and B.Tech and are in job today. Recently, a child student of this school, after passing out primary level completed 10+2 and computer course and serving as Teacher in Chetna school itself.

## **CHETNA VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE**

In pursuance of Kaushal Bharat Kushal Bharat Abhiyan by the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narender Modi ji, Chetna is actively involved in this movement. Efforts are being made by Chetna to empower the women from the weaker section of the society by providing absolutely free Vocational training in the following areas:

- · Tailoring
- Beauty Culture
- Computer Learning

Chetna aims at making these economically backward women self-dependent and enable

them to earn their livelihood in respectable manner.

Presently there are 18 girls undergoing training in Beauty Culture, while 15 are taking training in Tailoring, and 22 poor boys and girls in Computer Learning.

As per the feedback received from the trainees, and it is heartening to note that all the girls who completed the course in Tailoring and Beauty Culture are either self-employed or working in different beauty parlours. The Computer Learning has helped the trainees in finding the jobs easily.



## **EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

As already stated hereinabove, Chetna's main aim is to make Divyang Children, Street Children and Poor Women self-dependent to the extent possible and bring them in the main stream of the society, and as such we focus on overall personality development of these children, assess their hidden talent, and provide the following facilities in this context.

Dance and Music: Efforts are made to explore the hidden talent of such children and encouraging results have been noted. Help of professionals is also sought in this trade from time to time.

Yoga/Sports: Yoga specialists are invited to organise Yoga Classes from time to time to keep these children fit and healthy which helped these children in enhancing their stamina.

Parents Teachers Meet: Regular meetings are

organised between Parents of the children, Teachers and eminent social workers and apprise them of the importance of education for their children, avoidance of bad habits in them like smoking/drinking and sexual abuse of their women, family planning, cleanliness in and around their houses etc.

Health Check up Camps: General health check up camps are organised from time to time including dental and eye checking. Aneamic children are given appropriate medicines as well.
