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## अध्यक्षा की कलम से

### आदरणीय पाठकगण,

चेतना वेलफेयर सोसायटी वर्ष 2017-18 की वार्षिक रिपोर्ट स्वतंत्रता दिवस के उपलक्ष्य पर विमोचन करने पर मुझे अत्यन्त हर्ष हो रहा है। हमारी संस्था चेतना वेलफेयर सोसायटी, जो चेतना के नाम से प्रसिद्ध है, सामाजिक कल्याण कार्यों में निरन्तर प्रयासरत है। मैं इस संस्था के उज्ज्वल भविष्य की कामना करते हुए आशा करती हूँ कि चेतना जनहित कार्यों में प्रेरणास्रोत एवं एक मिसाल बनें।

यह बहुत गर्व व हर्ष की बात है कि आज भारत के नागरिकों में समाज के प्रति अपने दायित्व की जागरूकता बढ़ी है। और विशेषरूप से फरीदाबाद शहर में यहाँ शिक्षा के प्रति जागरूकता बढ़ी है वही समाज के उस वर्ग के बच्चों जिनका अपने मन व तन पर नियंत्रण नहीं है, यानि के वे बच्चों जो मानसिक व शारिरिक रूप से अक्षम हैं उनको सक्षम बनाकर समाज की मुख्य धारा में लाना अपना दायित्व ही नहीं, बल्कि धर्म व कर्म है।

महंगी शिक्षा के कारण कमजोर वर्ग के होनहार बच्चे चाहकर भी शिक्षा प्राप्त नहीं कर पाते, और इस सन्दर्भ में दिव्यांग बच्चों की शिक्षा और भी गम्भीर है। चेतना वेलफेयर सोसायटी (रजि.) ने इस तथ्य को मद्दे नजर रखते हुए चेतना स्कूल फॉर स्पेशल चिलड्रन की स्थापना की और आज न केवल 170 बच्चों जिनको अक्षम से सक्षम बनाने में प्रयासरत है, समाज में इस सन्दर्भ में जागरूकता में भी सफलतापूर्वक प्रयास कर रही है। साथ ही वो बच्चे जो गलीयों में बिना उद्देश्य धुमना व गंदी आदतों में लिप्त होना उनके लिए सत्यभावा स्कूल फॉर स्ट्रीट चिलड्रन खोला गया जहाँ आज करीब 200 बच्चों प्राइमरी स्कूल तक की शिक्षा प्राप्त कर रहे हैं, और प्राइमरी के बाद 10+2 के सरकारी स्कूलों में दाखिला दिलवाना और इन बच्चों के अभिभावकों के साथ लगातार सम्पर्क रखना एक चुनौतीपूर्ण कार्य में सफलतापूर्वक प्रयासरत है। ऐसे कई बच्चे संस्था के सहयोग से 10+2, बी.ए., बी. कॉम., बी. टैक जैसी शिक्षा प्राप्त कर आज नौकरियाँ कर रहे हैं। चेतना ने अभावग्रस्त महिलाओं को पिछले 15 वर्षों से सिलाई में प्रशिक्षण देकर उन्हें सफलतापूर्वक आत्मनिर्भर बनाने में और पिछले चार वर्ष से ब्यूटी पालेर प्रशिक्षण द्वारा एक और इस दिशा में ठोस कदम उठाया है। चेतना द्वारा किये जा रहे उपरोक्त सभी समाज कल्याण कार्य निःशुल्क है, और ये सम्भव हो पाया उन सभी आदरणीय दान दाताओं के सहयोग से जिनका मैं और समस्त कार्यकारणी तह दिल से धन्यवाद करती हूँ।

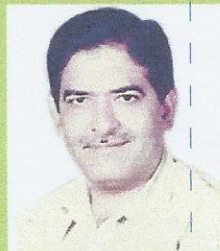

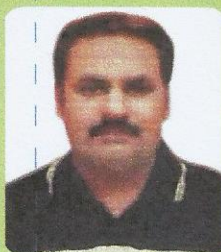

## An Excellent Performance 2017-18

## PREAMBLE

Chetna Welfare Society (Regd.), popularly known as Chetna was established in 2001, and today it is one of the leading NGO(non-profit non-governmental organisation) in the vicinity of Faridabad. Chetna was founded by a group of social think-tank concerning the issue of physically and mentally retarded children, often we called them Differently Abled children, and of late our Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji gave a respectable name as Divyang children. Although the present Government appears to be serious about rehabilitation of Divyang children, yet the onus lies on the Society to take up the cause of Divyang more seriously, and more particularly the NGOs like Chetna engaged in improving the lot of such children, who form the most neglected segment of the society. Chetna Welfare Society's aim is to provide Divyang children appropriate physiotherapy facility supported with special educator and speech therapist, and of-course the basic education and improving their personal hygiene, resultantly to make them self-dependent to the extent possible and bring them in the main stream of the society. Chetna which initially started in two rented rooms has now its own building on a plot of 600 sq. yds. at Sohna Road, Sanjay Colony, Near Punjab National Bank, Sector-23, NIT, Faridabad.



## *An Excellent Performance- Chetna*

Chetna Welfare Society in its continued untiring endeavour to render excellent services to Divyang children, Street Children and Women Empowerment thru Vocational Training Centres in Tailoring, Beauty Culture and Computer learning for weaker section of the society, it completed another year of excellent performance during the year 2017-2018. Chetna, a service oriented NGO, continuously strived to make Divyang and

Street children and women from poor segment of the society as self-dependent to the extent possible and bring them in the main stream of the society. Undoubtedly these milestones have been achieved with the dedicated efforts of the Management Committee, the staff and the above all the honourable donors and associates who extended sustainable support wholeheartedly.

### **Major Milestones Achieved**

The major milestones achieved during the year 2017-2018 are:

#### **Distribution of Books**

The children displayed the items made by them e.g. decoration items, diyas, candles, shagun envelopes, etc. The staff of the company showed keen interest in the activities of children and gave gifts to all the children and the accompanied teachers. President Smt. Rekha Sharma, Coordinator Sh.R.D.Sharma and Smt.Sunita Sharma, Sr. Welfare Officer of Chetna played vital role in this regard. Stall was also put up in the market of Sector-15, Faridabad with the courtesy of its President – Shri Manohar Puniani. The

### Uniform for Divyang and Street Children

Special uniform meant for Divyang children and normal uniform for street children were tailored made for them and the expenditure was borne by Smt. Manjit Kaur from Jullandhar, Punjab.

### CHERNA SCHOOL FOR DIVYANG CHILDREN

Divyang children, whose total number of such children as on date registered with Chetna is 172, received excellent support in terms of Physiotherapy, Special Educator, Speech Therapist besides basic education, skill development and awareness on hygiene, which has helped in improving their lifestyle. These children also performed cultural activities in functions organised in the campus from time to time which gave them wide exposure in building their self-confidence. Skill development training being imparted to them in making Candles, File Covers, Decorative Diyas, Decorative Tokris, Shagun envelopes has helped them in shaping their future and efforts to bring them in the main stream of the society.

#### Major facilities provided to Special Children:

- Physiotherapy Centre – a reasonably well-equipped physiotherapy facilities with the help of a qualified Physiotherapist. Around 20 children were major beneficiaries of the project.
- Special Educator provided professional skill in different trades
- Speech Therapist provided help in improving speech problems
- Transport facility – The NGO hires Eco Van for transportation of these special children for to and fro residence to school. With the help of Eco Van provided by IOCL the facility improved.



# SATYABHAVA SCHOOL FOR STREET CHILDREN



The Management Committee of Chetna Welfare Society, taking serious note of the plight of children from surroundings of its vicinity, who used to roam aimlessly on the roads, pick up fights using filthy language, pick up rags, and engaging themselves in other bad habits, established Satyabhava School for Street Children in the year 2008. Now the number of such children taking benefit of this school goes above 200. The Team – Chetna continued its efforts to make these children at par with other reputed

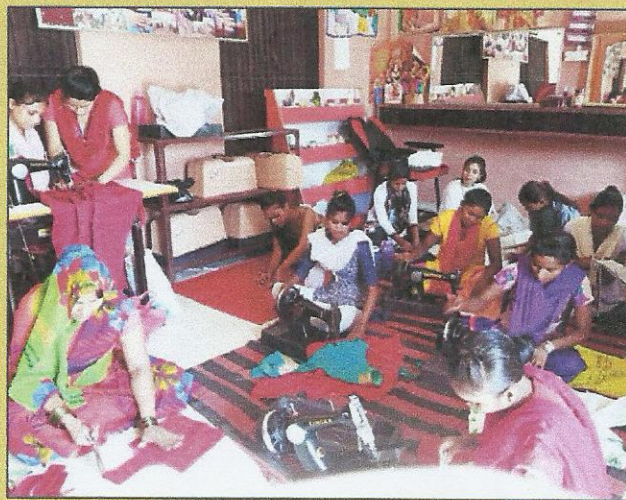
schools. The dedicated Team of Staff of Chetna treat such children with love and care so as to maintain their attraction towards the school. Help of motivators and educationists is also sought from time to time for these children and their parents so that parents get motivated to send their wards to the school regularly. The noteworthy feature of Team Chetna is that after the students pass out 5th class, regular contact is maintained with their parents and persuaded them to send to senior schools and every possible help is provided to them. It is heartening to note that several such children with the support of Chetna completed 10+2, BA, B.Com and B.Tech and are in job today.

## CHETNA VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE

Present Government under the leadership of Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi is very much concerned about Skill Development for youth, and Chetna in line with their Kaushal Bharat Kushal Bharat Abhiyan, efforts are being made by Chetna to empower the women from the weaker section of the society by providing absolutely free Vocational training in the following areas:

- Tailoring
- Beauty Culture
- Computer Learning

The purpose is to make these economically backward women self-dependent and enable them to earn their livelihood in respectable manner.



Presently there are 22 girls undergoing training in Beauty Culture, while 28 are taking training in Tailoring, and 14 poor boys and girls in Computer Learning.

The feedback is all the girls who completed the course in Tailoring and Beauty Culture are either self-employed or working in different beauty parlours.



## IndianOil Donates New Computers

Indian Oil Corporation, the largest public sector company in India, under its Corporate Social Responsibility Scheme donated 14 new Computers to Chetna Welfare Society. With this facility, the Computer Training Centre got strengthened and attracted the children to learn computer in big way. It is expected that in times to come, the large beneficiary will be benefitted. The picture shows

## EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

As already stated the main aim of Chetna is to make Divyang Children, Street Children and Poor Women self-dependent to the extent possible and bring them in the main stream of the society, as such we focus on personality development of these children, assess their hidden talent, and provide the following facilities in this context.

- Dance and Music: Efforts are made to explore the hidden talent of such children and encouraging results have been noted. Help of professionals is also sought in this trade from time to time.
- Yoga/Sports: Yoga specialists are invited to organise Yoga Classes from time to time to keep these children fit and healthy which helped these children in enhancing their stamina.
- Parents Teachers Meet: Regular meetings are organised between Parents of the children, Teachers and eminent social workers and apprise them of the importance of education for their children, avoidance of bad habits in them like smoking/drinking and sexual abuse of their women, family planning, cleanliness in and around their houses etc.
- Health Check up Camps: General health check up camps are organised from time to time including dental and eye checking. Anemic children are given appropriate medicines as well.
